CASA DE ESTUDILLO, OLD TOWN STATE HISTORIC PARK, SAN DIEGO, CA

The Casa de Estudillo in Old Town is not only about the Estudillo family that built it, but about the history of what is now known as San Diego. The Estudillo family built, lived in and expanded the Casa from a two room structure in 1827 to a 13 room U-shaped adobe that was their home until 1887. The re-installation of objects and interactives, and the re-interpretation of the Casa tells the story of the Estudillo men and women who were prominent in the region.

The Artefact team developed interior and exterior interactive exhibits, bilingual interpretive panels, audio experiences, and new access into seven of the rooms, presenting visitors a glimpse of what life was like for the early Spanish Mexican Californians. Open 2015
